Mourvèdre 100%

Terroir

Horizontal alluvial terraced soils dating back to the quaternary (alt. 35m). The top 2 meters of soil are composed of round silica pebbles amassed in clay mud, deposited on clay bedrock. The soils are exposed to windy conditions (Aeolian pebbles) and generous amounts of sunlight (more than 260 days per year) and are located about 4 kilometers from the Mediterranean Sea.

Working the wines

Manual disbudding and leaf-removal. Upon their arrival at the cellar, the grapes are sorted and stems are removed. Maceration. With some punching of the cap.

Only manual harvesting

Bottled: January 16, 2022 Production: 6,000 bottles of 75cl

Tasting notes

Intense, brilliant garnet color.

The nose is of rare complexity. It transports us between black fruits and scrubland, between strength and sweetness.

The palate is tasty, umami, with a bloody touch, dense and powerful... A Mourvèdre with a phenomenal length that you can't measure so much you salivate at the thought of soaking lips in the glass for another sip.

Suggested food pairing

Together dense and greedy at the same time, very good guard potential.... if we don't give in to the temptation... Will be the ideal companion of grilled beef ribs.

Ageing: 10 to 15 years

Why "Mataro Boy" ? On the label desired by Marie-Pierre figures Serge rugbyman powerful and elegant gestures then aged 20. The Mourvèdre is his favorite grape variety (Matarò in Catalan), it's really his signature. A wine that resembles him....



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
